

# Construction Laborer

## **JOB SUMMARY:**

To carry and load construction materials, tools, and equipment to skilled trade persons working on Footings and Poured Concrete Foundations.

## **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

1. Meet team leader at job site or yard. Load or unload construction materials, tools, and equipment, distribute them to particular work areas.
2. Organize additional materials, tools, and equipment and distribute to skilled trade persons, as needed, to allow the preparation and forming process to continue without delay.
3. Prepare sub-base by leveling stone with rake or other appropriate tool.
4. Prepare job site for concrete, by clearing all debris and collecting all unused materials, equipment, and tools from job site.
5. Remove, from truck, necessary tools needed to pour concrete (shovels, floats, pour pan, and any necessary safety equipment.
6. Unload concrete from concrete truck, and distribute by using truck chute or wheel-barrow, or others means, as directed by skilled trade persons.
7. After concrete pour is complete, wash of all tools using water from concrete truck, keep a bucket of water for additional clean- up activities.
8. Load all cleaned tools on truck and secure them for transport to next job site or back to yard area.
9. Strip, clean, load on truck or stage for crane loading, all form materials.

## **ADDITIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES:**

1. May have to drive to local building materials supply company to pick up rush- needed items.

## **JOB QUALIFICATIONS / REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Submit to and pass, Latorre Concrete Construction, Inc.'s Substance Abuse Testing Policy.
2. Possess two valid and original identifications as required by law.
3. Ability to lift and carry up to 80 pounds, push wheel-barrow loaded with concrete.
4. Job involves carrying materials, tools, and equipment up and down ladders.
5. Ability to climb forms and walk on 5 1/2" whaler boards
6. Required tools: hammer, 25ft. tape measure, work gloves, work shoes or boots, nail apron and rubber boots.
